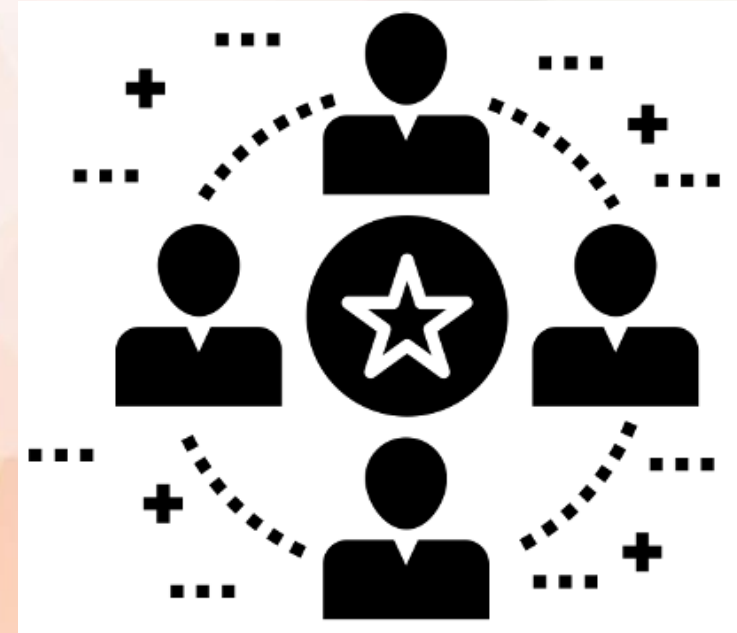


Kigali – Coordination: E-Mobility Technical Committee

- **Commitment:** High-level, political
- **NDC:** Inclusion of Electric Vehicles in the 2020 revised version
- **Strategy:** Inclusion of e-mobility in 2021 National Transport Policy and Strategy
- **Incentives:** Ambitious monetary and non-monetary measures to support the uptake of e-mobility adopted in April 2021
- **Initiatives:** Numerous private and public stakeholders supporting e-mobility



- **Coordination:** Technical Committee to coordinate e-mobility roll-out
